Trumpet Daffodils: The corona or trumpet is as long as or longer than the petals. Div. 1 Large Cup Daffodils: The corona is more than 1/3 but less than the length of the petals. Div. 2

Small Cup Daffodils: The corona is less than 1/3 the length of the petals. Div. 3

SCHEDULE

Class FLOWER ARRANGEMENT

1. A Spring arrangement. Overall size not to exceed 18" x 18" x 18".

BULBS: Growing in a pot or bowl of any size which may contain any number.

- 2. Daffodils. Height over 12"
- 3. Daffodils. Height under 12"
- 4. Hyacinths or Tulips.
- 5. Any other bulbs, pseudobulbs or corms.

PLANTS

Please do name your varieties if you can!

- 6. Any flowering house plant.
- 7. Any foliage house plant.
- 8. Any succulent or cactus.

CUT FLOWERS and SHRUBS

9. Daffodils. Trumpet or large cup Three blooms (one flower per stem) of same variety.

Div. 1 & 2

10. Daffodils. Small cup
Div. 3

Three blooms (one flower per stem) of same variety.

- 11. Miniature Daffodils. Three stems of same variety.
- Any other Daffodils: Doubles, Multi-headed, etc. Three stems of same variety. Div. 4 onwards.
- 13. Hellebores. Three stems any variety.
- 14. Camellias. Three sprays of same variety.
 15. Any other flowering shrub or tree. Three sprays of same variety.
- 15. Any other flowering shrub or tree. Three sprays of same variety.
 16. An arrangement of garden flowers in a teapot...no lid required! (SPECIAL PRIZE).
